

**ORDINANCE NO. 1144**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CAMARILLO AMENDING CHAPTER 10.44 OF THE  
CAMARILLO MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PARK  
REGULATIONS**

The City Council of the City of Camarillo ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1: Findings.** The City Council of the City of Camarillo finds as follows:

A. The City wishes to amend Section 10.44.020 of the Camarillo Municipal Code to clarify language.

**SECTION 2: Environmental Review.** The City Council exercises its independent judgment and finds that this ordinance is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Section 15060(c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and Section 15060(c)(3) (the activity is not a project as defined in Section 15378) of the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, because the subject regulations have no potential for resulting in any significant physical change to the environment, directly or indirectly.

**SECTION 3.** Amend and replace Section 10.44.020 to shall read as follows:

"10.44.020 – Prohibited Acts – City Property

No member of the public shall commit any of the following acts on Constitution Park, Dizdar Park, Library Property exterior to Library Building and "F"-Canyon ("City Property"):

- A. Use by organized sports teams;
- B. Possess or use any radio or remote controlled devices including, but not limited to, airplanes, cars, unmanned aerial vehicles, drones or other radio or remote controlled devices;
- C. Use playground or other park equipment or improvements for other than intended use;
- D. Cycling, scooters, skateboard, roller skating and inline skating on City Property designated by Resolution of the City Council pursuant to Camarillo Municipal Code Section 11.76.010 A.
- E. Possess or use weapons, guns, knives, spears, swords, bow and arrow, paintball guns, airsoft guns or any object that propels projectiles of any kind;
- F. Possess or use a javelin, shot put, lawn darts or other sports equipment which has the potential to cause injury to other persons at the park;
- G. Use trees for: climbing, swinging or attaching anything to a tree;
- H. Play or practice baseball (hardball and softball), golf and other sports which involve hitting a ball. However, this prohibition does not apply to low impact sports such as whiffle ball and similar type sports;

- I. Participate in activities which pose a risk of injury to participant or the public;
- J. Participate in activities which may cause damage to City Property;
- K. Use City Property anytime other than sunrise to sunset except for City buildings and parking lots with permission of the City;
- L. Possess or use cooking devices including, but not limited to, grills, barbeque or other cooking devices unless with a cooking device provided for public use by the City;
- M. Conduct any business;
- N. Possess or use amplified sound equipment or devices of any kind;
- O. Possess or use bounce houses, jumpers or other inflatables;
- P. Possess or use alcohol or illegal drugs;
- Q. Smoke, vape or ingest tobacco or marijuana products;
- R. Unleash animals or pets;
- S. Leave any animal or pet waste undisposed;
- T. Possess or operate motorized vehicles or devices other than maintenance or service vehicles."

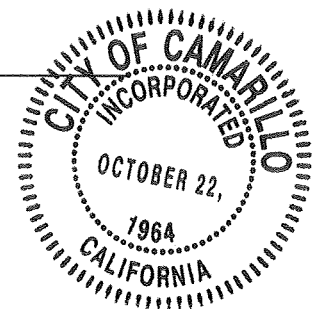

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-98

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMARILLO, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A PROHIBITION ON RIDING BICYCLES, INLINE SKATES, ROLLER SKATES AND SKATEBOARDS ON CITY PROPERTY AS DEFINED IN THIS RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO CAMARILLO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.76.010

The City Council of the City of Camarillo resolves as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The City Council of the City of Camarillo finds and declares that:

A. Under Camarillo Municipal Code section 11.76.010(A), the City Council may, by resolution, prohibit persons from riding, propelling or in any manner operating a bicycle, skateboard, roller skates or inline skates on, along, or over any public sidewalk or right-of-way or other public property of the City designated by the City Council by resolution.

B. On December 9, 2009, the City Council adopted Resolution 2009-183 to prohibit persons from riding bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or inline skates on, along or over any public sidewalk or right-of-way in the sidewalk areas on the south side of Ventura Boulevard from Colonia Place to Glenn Drive, and on the north side from Cedar Drive to Lewis Road.

C. The City Council desires to include additional City property to the locations where riding bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or inline skates will be prohibited as set forth below.

D. "City Property" for purposes of this Resolution only is defined as Constitution Park, Dizdar Park, Camarillo Library courtyard and the public sidewalk or right-of-way in the sidewalk areas on the south side of Ventura Boulevard from Colonia Place to Glenn Drive, and on the north side from Cedar Drive to Lewis Road.

E. In order to minimize potentially conflicting uses with pedestrians, the City Council desires to prohibit persons from riding bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or inline skates on City Property as defined in this Resolution.

**SECTION 2:** All persons, other than law enforcement personnel engaged in their duties, are hereby prohibited from riding or operating a bicycle, or using a skateboard, roller skates or inline skates to propel themselves on City Property as defined in this Resolution.


**SECTION 3:** Resolution 2009-183 is hereby rescinded because its provisions in regard to Ventura Boulevard are included within this Resolution.

**SECTION 4:** City staff is directed to post appropriate notice of this prohibition in such locations and in such manner as is consistent with Camarillo Municipal Code section 11.76.010(B).

**SECTION 5:** This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.

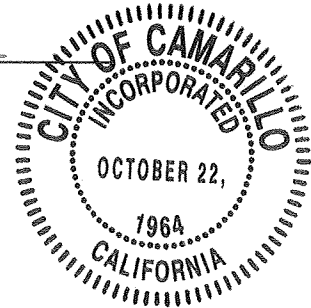
