NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Camarillo will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, March 27, 2019, at 7:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 601 Carmen Drive, Camarillo, California, to consider the following:

Year 2019-2020

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds Allocations

The City Council recommendations will be incorporated into the Draft 2019-2020 Action Plan. The amount of the FY 2018-2019 allocation was \$310,228. The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has not yet announced the FY 2019-2020 CDBG allocations.

The CDBG Program administered by HUD was established by Congress in 1974. The primary objective is the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities, principally, for persons of low and moderate income. CDBG funds may be used for a variety of activities that generally fall into the following major categories: 1) housing, 2) public facilities, and 3) economic development. A portion of the funds (a maximum of 15% of the total grant) may be used for public service activities.
