



CITY OF CAMARILLO COMBINED PUBLIC NOTICE

AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT FY 2019/20 ACTION PLAN and PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, the City of Camarillo will release a Draft Fiscal Year (FY) 2019/20 Action Plan for a 30-day public review period beginning on May 10, 2019, and ending on June 9, 2019.

The Draft FY 2019/20 Action Plan provides a comprehensive one-year strategy that addresses the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to meet the goals of providing decent housing, providing a suitable living environment, and providing expanded economic opportunities for low- and moderate-income persons. The CDBG funds will be allocated for the next program year (July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020).

The Draft FY 2019/20 Action Plan will be available for public review beginning on May 10, 2019, at: (1) the Community Development Department located at Camarillo City Hall, 601 Carmen Drive; (2) the Camarillo Library, located at 4101 Las Posas Road; and (3) the City's website at www.cityofcamarillo.org.

The Camarillo City Council will conduct a **public hearing on Wednesday, June 12, 2019**, at 7:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers located at 601 Carmen Drive, Camarillo, to receive public comments on the Draft FY 2019/20 Action Plan, and to approve the final document for submission to HUD. All interested persons are encouraged to submit comments on the draft plan on, or before, the June 12, 2019, public hearing.
