NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Camarillo will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, September 25, 2019, at 7:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 601 Carmen Drive, Camarillo, California, to consider the following:

DRAFT FISCAL YEAR 2018/19 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, the City of Camarillo will release the Draft Fiscal Year (FY) 2018/19 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) for a 15-day public review period beginning on September 10, 2019, and ending on September 24, 2019. The Draft FY 2018/19 CAPER will be available for public review at the Community Development Department, located at the Camarillo City Hall, 601 Carmen Drive, and at the Camarillo Library, located at 4101 Las Posas Road. It will also be available on the City's website at www.cityofcamarillo.org.

The Draft FY 2018/19 CAPER reports on Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs administered by the City of Camarillo for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. The Camarillo City Council will review the CAPER at its September 25, 2019 regular meeting. If approved, the CAPER will be submitted to HUD on September 27, 2019.

All interested persons are encouraged to submit comments on, or before, the September 25, 2019, public hearing.
