

ORDINANCE NO. 1164

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMARILLO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING AND RESTATING SECTION 11.20.100 OF THE CAMARILLO MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PARKING TIME LIMITATIONS ON PUBLIC STREETS AND PUBLIC PARKING FACILITIES

The City Council of the City of Camarillo ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Findings. The City Council of the City of Camarillo finds as follows:

A. The City desires to amend Section 11.20.100 of the Camarillo Municipal Code to clarify that properly identified parking limitations on streets throughout the city, and on offstreet public parking facilities, shall be enforced by the Camarillo Police Department.

B. The City of Camarillo, a local authority, is a municipality having authority to adopt local police regulations.

C. Per California Vehicle Code Section 22507, the City of Camarillo by ordinance or resolution prohibits or restricts the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles during all or certain hours of a day on specified streets, street segments and publically owned parking facilities.

SECTION 2. Environmental Review. The City Council exercises its independent judgment and finds that this ordinance is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Section 15060(c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and Section 15060(c)(3) (the activity is not a project as defined in Section 15378) of the CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, because the subject regulations have no potential for resulting in any significant physical change to the environment, directly or indirectly.

SECTION 3. Amend and replace Section 11.20.100 to read as follows:

11.20.100 - Parking Time Limitations

No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon a public street segment or public parking lot in violation of any time restriction or limitation of such stopping or standing or parking as posted or marked on said public street segment or public parking lot by the Director of Public Works. A vehicle in violation of such parking time restriction or limitation is subject to citation and removal.

SECTION 4. Publication. The City Clerk is directed to certify this ordinance and cause it to be published in the manner required by law.
