

By Laws of the Camarillo Ranch Foundation

Article V. Section 4

Section 4. City Liaison Representatives. Two (2) members of the Camarillo City Council designated by the Mayor and approved by the City Council will serve as City liaison representatives to the Foundation. Such representatives will not be members of the Board and will not have any voting rights at Board meetings. Their role will be to provide input and advice to the Board on behalf of the City and the City Council, and to report on Foundation activities to the City Council. City liaison representatives to the Foundation shall serve for two (2) year terms; provided that a City liaison representative may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by a majority vote of the City Council of Camarillo. City liaison representatives shall continue to be members of the City Council during their tenure.

~~Ex-Officio Members. Two (2) members of the Camarillo City Council designated by the Mayor, and approved by the City Council, shall serve as Ex-Officio non-voting members of the Board. Ex-Officio members shall serve for two (2) year terms; provided that an Ex-Officio member may be removed at any time, with or without cause, by a majority vote of the City Council of Camarillo. Ex-Officio members shall continue to be members of the City Council during their tenure.~~
