Is the City processing plans for improvements such as new accessory structures, additions, and tenant improvements during Ventura County's Stay Well at Home Order?

YES! Please contact the Community Development Department by calling 805.388.5360 or via email at planning@cityofcamarillo.org and attach a site plan, elevations, and floor plan. Include a copy of the Homeowner's Association approval (if applicable).

Is Construction allowed during Ventura County's Stay Well at Home Order?

YES! Construction activities have been deemed essential and are allowed to continue during the Stay Well at Home order. All contractors and construction workers are to review the social distancing guidelines of the Stay Well at Home order and practice social distancing and proper safety procedures at all times.

Is the City still doing inspections for final building permit sign off?

May I open a new business or change the address for my business in Camarillo?
