



IMPORTANT NEWS ABOUT NEW MANDATORY RECYCLING LAW

Starting July 1, 2012 State Assembly Bill 341 makes recycling mandatory for commercial businesses in California. This legislation applies to all businesses that generate four-cubic yards or more of trash each week. This includes any commercial parks, strip malls or property complexes with two or more commercial entities. Since you are receiving this letter, you have been identified as a business that falls under the requirements of this new legislation.

Although most businesses in the City already have some recycling in place, there is often confusion about what can be put into the containers resulting in high contamination levels or valuable recyclable items ending up in the trash. The intent of the legislation is not just having a recycling bin on the property but making sure employees are well informed, using it properly and maximizing diversion of materials.

To help support your current efforts, the City of Camarillo and Harrison Industries provides free assessments and resources to enhance your existing business recycling program. You may also receive free desk-side recycling boxes and beverage recycling containers for your kitchen areas.
